

## **ELEMENTARY PODCAST JUDGING PROCESS - 45 MINUTES**

- 1. First, you will introduce yourself to the judges and announce the title of your podcast.
- **2.** Next, everyone will listen to your podcast.
- **3.** When your group has listened to all of the podcasts, the judges will gather all of the students together and will talk with you about your experience.
  - > The judges are not using your answers as part of your evaluation
  - > You can choose to raise your hand or to listen to others
  - > You can mention things you really liked in some of the podcasts you listened to
  - > Be sure to make new friends

Don't worry about talking with the judges. They'll only be asking questions from this list:

- O How did you choose your topic?
- How did you research your topic?
- How does your topic connect to this year's theme?
- How did you create your project?
- What did you learn that surprised you?
- What source was the most helpful?
- What would you like to know more about?
- What was most challenging about creating a Podcast?
- What was the most fun part about creating a Podcast?
- What advice do you have for other students who want to create a History Day Podcast?

## What happens after the interview?

- → There will be no final judging round for the podcast category. Instead, judges will select a winner and runner-up from each heat.
- → Awards will be presented at the ceremony scheduled for Saturday afternoon at 3:00 p.m.
