

Elementary Poster Judging Process – 45 minutes

First, you will participate in a gallery walk:

- Talk to the other students in your heat
- Use post-it notes to leave comments on their posters
- Share your work with other students

Then, the judges will talk with you about your poster:

- You'll stand next to your poster and wait your turn
- The judges will ask you some questions about your research
- Once the judges move to the next project, you are done!
- Exit the building and celebrate all your hard work

Don't worry about talking with the judges. They'll only ask you questions from this list:

- 1. How did you choose your topic?
- 2. How did you research your topic?
- 3. How does your topic connect to this year's theme?
- 4. How did you create your project?
- 5. What did you learn that surprised you?
- 6. What source was the most helpful?
- 7. What would you like to know more about?

What to Bring:

- Bring Four copies of your Title Page, Process Paper and Annotated Bibliography.
- When you have finished setting up, leave 4 copies at your poster and mark one "DISPLAY COPY." You may also want to bring an additional copy for your own reference.
- There will be no final judging round for the poster category. Instead, judges will select a winner and runner-up from each heat.
- Awards will be presented at the ceremony scheduled for Friday afternoon at 3:00 p.m.
