



Think about your topic on a river of history. Rivers have tributaries and confluences. Rivers also have a lot of turns. Where on the river of your period of history does your turning point occur?


1. Label your river with the period of history your topic is in.

4. What will you need to know before you go on this river journey?




5. What are the must sees when you arrive at your turning point?
