Interviews: Historical paper state finalists will be interviewed by a panel of judges at California History Day. Judges will have already reviewed the

papers in advance of the contest. Interviews are not open to the public.

Viewing Papers: All finalist papers will be on display in the Exhibit Hall during the Project Showcase at the event.

Final-Round Judging: There is no final round for historical papers. Winners will be selected from the 12 Junior and 12 Senior papers.
